BASES

Mobility and internationalization are key elements of research, and they are one of priorities outlined by the European Union's "Horizon 2020" research program framework, in order to create an attractive research career model, complementing researchers' skills and encouraging their transnational and intersectoral mobility.

To this end, as part of the **Regional Programme "Jimenez de la Espada" for Mobility, Cooperation and Internationalization** run by the Fundación Séneca, Agency for Science and Technology in the Region of Murcia, the framework of the 2017 Work Programme encompasses a series of actions aiming to encourage mobility and scientific exchange, supporting the scientific career of researchers in the Region of Murcia and strengthening the research capacity of groups and centres through the creation and consolidation of bonds for international collaboration, attraction of talent, and the exchange of knowledge. The actions comprising the Programme are:

a) Fellowships for external research stays for researchers from the Region of Murcia at foreign centres: to provide financial support for internships at renowned foreign research centres of experienced researchers, with accredited professional careers, who are associated to universities and research organizations in the Region of Murcia.

b) Fellowship for guest researcher visits to attract researchers with experience and accredited professional careers at renowned international research centres who wish to undertake an internship with teams belonging to universities and research centres in the Region of Murcia, helping to develop their research areas.

c) Financial aid to organize scientific and technical meetings and conferences: preferably international, to make the Region of Murcia a hub of scientific exchange and discussion of results and progress among researchers from around the world.

The Fundación Séneca participates with the "Jiménez de la Espada" Programme in the EURAXESS Network (<http://ec.europa.eu/euraxess>), promoted by the European Commission to remove obstacles to the mobility of researchers and their families when moving within the European Research Area. As the EURAXESS node for the Region of Murcia, the Fundación Séneca makes the MURCIAMOBILITY (www.fseneca.es/murciamobility) portal available to the research community, as well as a service to facilitate researcher mobility.

FIRST.- OBJECT

This Call aims to attract research talent, to promote the acquisition of new knowledge, skills and abilities of research teams in the Region of Murcia, as well as to encourage scientific exchange and internationalization of science and technology. To do so, internships will be funded for researchers with proven experience associated with prestigious foreign research centres carrying out research at a university or public or private non-profit research centre based in the Region of Murcia.

SECOND.- BENEFICIARIES

This Call is addressed to researchers with doctoral degrees awarded prior to December 31, 2010 with accredited international research experience and trajectory.

THIRD.- REQUIREMENTS

3.1.- Requirements of the visiting researchers

Applicants for this call must meet the following requirements:

- a) At the time of their application submission they must hold the PhD degree, obtained before December 31, 2010. The date of award of the PhD degree will be understood as the *viva* and approval of the same.
- b) They must have at the time of making the application an accredited functional or contractual association, either teaching or research, with a prestigious foreign research centre, which must be maintained during the stay. In the event that the accredited link with a research centre has expired, the application will be excluded and, if previously granted, it will be revoked.
- c) They must have accredited international research experience, with relevant and recent contributions in the research field to be developed during the internship in the Region of Murcia. The proposed activity must constitute original and effective research that is valuable and of interest to the host group.
- d) They must not have undertaken a stay in 2016 or 2017 in centres in the Region of Murcia funded by a fellowship granted under the call *Ayudas a la Realización de Estancias de Investigadores Visitantes* within the Regional Programme "Jiménez de la Espada" run by the Séneca Foundation;
- e) In the case of those born in the Region of Murcia, they must not have resided in the Region of Murcia in the last 5 years.

All requirements must be fulfilled at the time of the application submission and compliance must be maintained, and, if applicable, accredited both on the date of commencement of the stay and throughout the same.

3.2.- Requirements of the researcher responsible for the host group

- a) The researcher in charge of the host group must be tenured under civil service or teaching or research contract full time with a university or research centre, public or private non-profit organization, based in the Region of Murcia, which must be conserved throughout the stay.
- b) Be the Principal Investigator of a current research project in the research field object of the requested internship, or have accredited, relevant and recent scientific publications in this field of investigation.
- c) No research group from the Region of Murcia will be able to receive more than one visiting researcher under this call.

The beneficiaries of this fellowship cannot meet any of the causes of incompatibility or prohibition to obtain the status of beneficiary of subsidies established under article 13, paragraphs 2 and 3 of Law 38/2003, of 17 November, *General de Subvenciones*.



FOURTH.- DURATION OF THE STAY AND CONDITIONS

The duration of the stay shall be **three months** minimum and **six months** maximum, and will be subject to the following conditions:

- a) Must necessarily be carried out during the following period: from **June 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018**.
The stay must coincide with the periods of scientific activity of the host centres, the month of August being considered non-working. However, the Fundación Séneca may authorize the undertaking of a stay during these months when it is accredited in the invitation certificate (base 6, letter e, section 6) that during this period the host research team will maintain full scientific activity.
- b) The stay will be undertaken uninterruptedly, except by *force majeure* or fortuitous circumstances duly accredited and authorized by the Fundación Séneca. The stay will be on a full-time basis, and will imply geographic and academic mobility with respect to the beneficiaries' places of employment, with an effective change of habitual residence and presence at the receiving centre for the entire duration of the stay
- c) The stay should be undertaken at a university or non-profit public or private research centre located in the Region of Murcia, with full submission to its operating rules.
- d) The aim of the internship will be to conduct original research work to promote the consolidation, growth and internationalization of research fields undertaken by the host team, and scientific collaboration shall benefit from its development and results.
- e) The applicant must have the approval of their own centre, with the formal invitation of the principal investigator of the host research group endorsed by the legal representative of the university or research centre to which the said team belongs
- f) The date of commencement of the internship proposed in the application may not be changed except on duly justified and exceptional grounds, which must first be authorized by the Fundación Séneca. Under no circumstances shall an extension in the start or end date of the internship be permitted for a period exceeding two months. The effective duration of the internship cannot be extended beyond June 30, 2018.

FIFTH. - ALLOCATION AND IMBURSEMENT

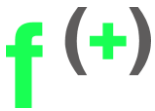
The fellowship awarded to each beneficiary includes the following:

- a) A maximum monthly allocation of 2.250 €;
- b) The cost of a round trip, economy class, to the host centre destination, on the terms described in the Sixth Base herein;
- c) Accident insurance;
- d) Beneficiaries whose country of residence is not within the European Union, the European Economic Area or Switzerland (i.e., countries where healthcare is covered by the Social Security/National Health welfare systems, and are thus holders of a European Health Insurance Card) are entitled to healthcare insurance. Said healthcare insurance shall be contracted and paid for by the Fundación Séneca once the beneficiary of the fellowship notifies of their start date.

Neither health insurance, if the event, nor accident insurance will cover the relatives of the visiting researcher.

The award of a fellowship does not imply a contractual or statutory relationship with the Fundación Séneca or with the host university or centre.

The fellowship will be paid to the beneficiary monthly in arrears, into an account in the beneficiary's name, at a bank legally recognized in Spain, and once the documents stated in the Eleventh Base have been submitted.



The last monthly payment and the amount to cover round-trip travel expenses, or the return trip, are subject to the submission of the scientific and economic supporting documents of the fellowship under the conditions stated in the Tenth Base, herein.

These amounts are subject to the tax legislation in force. Consideration will be made of the situation of researchers from countries with which there are Agreements to avoid double taxation, and who must provide, on arrival, an original certificate of tax residence issued by the tax authorities of their country of origin.

Fellowships will become effective pursuant to budget availability.

SIXTH.- APPLICATIONS AND INFORMATION REQUIRED

Formalization of the application and application processing requires that the applicant fills in their personal and professional data, related to the activity to be undertaken during the stay, and all other necessary information, at the electronic site pertaining to the Fundación Séneca -Agency for Science and Technology of the Region of Murcia.

The application is divided into the following sections:

a) Application: This section will include those Call-specific data not requested on user registration;

b) Activity: In this section enter data regarding the proposed stay and information about the proposed host centre.

c) Expenses: This section shall contain the funding requested to cover travel expenses. Travel by plane, train and coach, in tourist class, shall be eligible as well as travel to and from the airport or station concerned. When using your own car, mileage will be paid at a rate of 0.19 €/km. Without exception, the amount to cover travel costs, whatever the means of transport, shall not exceed the following maximum limits: 600 € for travel from within Europe; 1200 € for transcontinental journeys.

d) Annexes. In this section, the applicant should upload the following documents to their application:

Annex 1: "Scientific information". This file includes four sections:

- Report of research activities to be performed during the internship and the reasons why they represent a valuable and significant contribution to the research being undertaken by the host team and their contribution to internationalization;
- Brief scientific track-record of the investigator in charge of the host team as of January 1, 2012, indicating the current research projects relating to the research aim of the requested internship and relevant and recent scientific publications on that topic;
- Scientific track-record of the host group at January 1, 2012;
- Host team's justification of the impact of the proposed internship and the specific benefits that this activity will have on the development and internationalization of one or more of their research areas and acquisition of results.

Annex 2: CV and research experience of the applicant as of January 1, 2012. This file includes the standard curriculum vitae model of the Ministry of Economy, Industry and Competitiveness, which should reflect exclusively the scientific activity performed as of January 1 2012. The standard CV of the Fundación Séneca will also be accepted. The use of any other CV model other than those mentioned in this section will lead to exclusion of the application.

Annex 3: "PhD accreditation". The official document accrediting the date of the PhD must be attached in pdf format.

Annex 4: "Link with the home institution". Here, an official document must be attached in pdf format, accrediting the statutory or contractual relationship of the applicant, which must be currently active and ongoing with full-time and exclusive dedication to a university or public research centre located abroad. This document must include the start and end date of the contract in the case of a non-indefinite link to the said centre.



Annex 5: "Invitation by the host centre". Here the formal invitation from the principal investigator in charge of the host group, endorsed by the legal representative of the centre to which the host group belongs, that must be attached in pdf format. It must include the centre, laboratory or unit at which the stay and the line of work is to be undertaken. It will also indicate whether the scientific activity of the host team continues during the month of August.

Annex 6 "Authorization of data". This annex will include an authorization form whereby the interested party may authorize the Fundación Séneca, Regional Agency of Science and Technology, itself or through the competent Ministry in the matter of universities, to consult and / or issue the certificates in order to stay abreast of tax and fiscal obligations with the State Administration and with the Autonomous Region and, as the case may be, of its obligations with Social Security, in order to comply with the provisions of the Spanish General Grants Law (Ley General de Subvenciones). The applicant must fill the document in and sign it (in blue), and then scan it in colour and attach it to the application form.

All documents to be provided in this Call must be in pdf format (Adobe Acrobat version 7 or more recent) or Word (Version 2003 or more recent).

No more than one application may be submitted by each interested party.

The presentation of the application entails the authorization for the communication to third parties of the data collected in the same, for the purpose of the subsequent data processing for historical, statistical or scientific purposes, within the framework of Organic Law 15/1999 of 13 of December, of Protection of Personal Data.

SEVENTH.- APPLICATION DEADLINE AND SUBMISSION

Applications must be submitted electronically through the online application function of the Fundación Séneca-Agencia de Ciencia y Tecnología de la Región de Murcia, available on the Internet at: <http://www.fseneca.es>.

Log on to the Web application once only (by consecutively selecting "private zone+registration" located in the field "About Us" on the home page, "Register/New User" and "APPLICANT") and complete all obligatory fields.

The applicant shall gain access to the software application by entering his/her user name, password and the security number on the screen, or by means of electronic ID or electronic certificate, which will enable him/her to complete and submit the application. Likewise, applicants can check the stage thereof during processing at the electronic home of the Fundación Séneca: <https://www.fseneca.es/acceso/html/entrada.htm>

Applicants will be responsible for the accuracy and authenticity of the information contained therein. Concealment, misrepresentation or manipulation of these shall lead to immediate exclusion of the application or should it become apparent once the fellowship has been granted, the revocation of the same with repayment of the amounts received.

The deadline for submission of applications will remain open until 2:00 pm on April 27, 2017.

Applications that are not duly completed and registered or that do not comply with all the requirements of the present regulations will be definitively excluded from the scientific-technical evaluation process without further processing.

The documentation and information provided after the closing of the call will not be taken into account in the evaluation process.

EIGHTH.-MANAGEMENT AND EVALUATION OF APPLICATIONS.

Subsequent to the deadline for application submission, the Fundación Seneca shall verify compliance with the requirements set for admissibility of the same, as well as their relevance to the Call objectives. Proposals will only undergo the scientific evaluation process when they have passed this assessment step.



Scientific and technical assessment will be performed by a Panel of Scientific and Technological Experts composed of reviewers of recognized research standing and consolidated track-record from universities and research and innovation centres outside the Region of Murcia.

The evaluation process will be carried out according to criteria of merit, capacity and non-discrimination in conditions that ensure the access and publicity to the fellowships under the Call.

The evaluators will act in accordance with criteria of competence, impartiality, objectivity, freedom and independence of judgment to express their opinion on the proposals submitted for their consideration, absence of conflict of interests and confidentiality, and formally assume the appropriate commitments before having access to the proposals.

Applications accepted will be evaluated on the basis of the following criteria:

A. Curriculum vitae and research experience of the applicant during the last five years, especially in the area of research that is the subject of the stay. Maximum of 40 points.

- Career and scientific-technical contribution of the candidate expressed through articles published in indexed scientific journals, books or chapters of scientific and technical books, participation or direction of competitive research projects, papers presented at conferences, technology transfer activity accredited through Research developed under contract, creation of companies based on knowledge and technology, registered patents, especially those that are in operation, and, in general, other relevant results of their scientific and technical activity. Score: 0 to 30 points.
- International dimension of the research activity of the applicant, including mobility, development of stays in international R & D centres, participation in international projects, participation as a reviewer or editor in indexed international journals, etc. Score: from 0 to 8 points.
- Relevant scientific-technical awards and recognition obtained by the candidate, invitation to present at prestigious conferences, accredited activity of scientific dissemination and other merits not eligible for inclusion in the previous sections. Score: from 0 to 2 points

B. Proposed Research Activity to be undertaken at the Host's Organization. Maximum of 40 points

- Quality, originality and scientific-technical and innovative interest of the proposal, proposed work plan, objectives and possibility of achieving them in the duration of the stay. Impact of scientific activity. Techniques for the generation of new knowledge, its application or transference. The accredited existence of a prior scientific relationship between the receiving group and the visiting researcher or their group of origin will be evaluated. Score: from 0 to 40 points.

C. Trajectory of the host research team during the last five years. Maximum 10 points

- Relevance and international trajectory of the host group and its responsible researcher in the line of research object of the requested stay. This will be assessed through articles published in indexed scientific journals, books or chapters of scientific and technical books, development of research projects, papers presented In congresses, knowledge transfer activity accredited by research developed under contract, patents granted or licensed, or creation of companies based on knowledge and technology, as well as, in general, other relevant results of their scientific and technical activity. Score: 0 to 10 points.

D. Specific benefits of the proposed activity. Maximum 10 points

- Benefits provided by the proposed activity for the development and internationalization of the research lines of the applicant and their possible impact on the activity of the research group to which they belong. Score: from 0 to 10 points



Applications will be assigned to the application area selected by the candidate, where they will be evaluated. The Evaluation Committee is empowered to transfer the proposals to other areas if, in their opinion, these are better adapted to their characteristics and objectives.

After the evaluation phase, they will issue a scientific-technical report on each application and a prioritized award proposal.

NINTH.- CONCESSION

Once the evaluation process has been completed, the Fundación Séneca will provide the Chairperson of the Board with a prioritized proposal for financing adjusted to the results of the scientific and technical evaluation of the Evaluation Committee and taking into account the budget available for the Program, in order to dictate Resolution granting and refusal of aid. The Board of Trustees, through its President, and having obtained the previous approval provided for in Additional Provision Sixteen of Law 38/2003, of November 17, General of Subsidies, will issue a resolution granting or refusing aid.

TENTH.- PUBLICATION, NOTIFICATION, REVISION AND ACCEPTANCE OF FELLOWSHIPS

The resolution of the Call, with respect to approved applications, will be published on the Website of Fundación Séneca. The award of fellowships and implementation normative for proper administration of the same, shall also be conveyed to each individual applicant.

The successful applicants may accept the fellowship by accessing their private area and selecting the appropriate Call, where they will find the option "Accept".

Within the fifteen calendar days following the publication of the resolution of the Call, the Fundación Séneca will make available the scientific and technical assessment reports to all evaluated applicants. Within this period, these applicants may exercise in writing the right of reply, in the exercise of which no new facts or circumstances may be provided that could not be taken into account during the evaluation process. In the event that the claim is based on the sufficiently founded disagreement with the result of the scientific-technical evaluation carried out, the Fundación will submit it to a new report. If this confirms the unfavourable evaluation of the proposal, said evaluation will be considered final and will not give rise to a new claim.

ELEVENTH.- OBLIGATIONS

Fellowship beneficiaries will comply with the following obligations:

- 1) Those beneficiaries whose country of origin is not part of the European Union, the European Economic Area or Switzerland (countries for which health-care is covered by Spanish Social Security) must notify the Fundación Séneca of their travel date and date of arrival with a minimum of one week in advance, in order to process the relevant medical insurance.
- 2) Join the host centre on the starting date established in the application, unless deferment is expressly authorized by the Fundación Séneca. To accredit incorporation, the beneficiary shall submit, through their private user application on the Fundación Séneca Web site, the certificate of incorporation issued by the legal representative the host centre, stating the start date.
- 3) Foreign beneficiaries must provide Fundación Séneca photocopy of their Spanish NIE (foreigners' identification number). Without exception, the beneficiary must be legally registered in Spain, according to Spanish law regarding foreigners, throughout the period of stay. Information about general legal requirements for foreigners in Spain can be found in the: Guía del investigador extranjero en España available at <http://www.euraxess.es/servicios/investigadores-extranjeros-en-espana>
- 4) Submit to the Fundación Séneca the certificate issued by a financial institution legally recognized in Spain, or photocopy of the savings account book, showing the IBAN number of which the beneficiary is title-holder.
- 5) For beneficiaries from countries with existing agreements, to avoid double taxation the beneficiary must present an original certificate of tax residence issued by the tax authorities of their country of origin, with a Spanish translation.



- 6) Carry out the proposed activity to maximum advantage and in accordance with the work plan and objectives. The activity must be carried out on a full-time basis and is incompatible with any other academic or professional activity. However, sporadic economic perceptions from teaching (courses, conferences or lectures) or researcher activities (books or articles) are allowed, provided they are directly related with the research work subject of the grant, and are carried out outside the work schedule.
- 7) Comply with the rules providing justification of expenses and of activity performance, control and monitoring of the stay, maintenance of the documentation and requirements set out in the corresponding bases.
- 8) Collaborate in outreach and communication activities related to the activity undertaken, at the request of the Fundación Séneca.
- 9) Acknowledge in all the scientific results of the activity funded, as well as in all communication or outreach actions of the same, the fellowship/sponsorship by the Fundación Séneca -Agency of Science and Technology of the Region of Murcia- through its Regional Programme "Jiménez de la Espada" for Research Mobility, Cooperation and Internationalization.

The first payment will be made once the certificate of incorporation provided for in number 2 of this base and the other documents required in this base have been duly submitted and received by the Fundación Séneca.

TWELFTH. - JUSTIFICATION.

l) Economic justification:

At the beginning of the stay, the outbound flight will be paid for in the event that the applicant can justify the gross amount of the travel expenses, one way or round-trip where appropriate, by submitting to the Fundación Séneca the tickets and boarding passes and original invoices or, in the event of electronic tickets, a printed copy. These documents must show the amount and the beneficiary must appear as the title-holder/traveller. The gross amount must be justified.

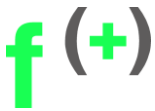
Within **30 (thirty) days** following the end of the internship stay, or before January 31, 2016 if the internship ends in September 17, 2018 if the stay ends on June 30, 2018, they must be filed with the Fundación Séneca:

1. Proof of travel expenses, round trip or one way, by filing the original tickets, boarding passes and invoices with the Fundación Séneca or, in case of electronic tickets, a printed copy. These documents must show the amount and the beneficiary must appear as the title-holder/traveller. The gross amount must be justified. Failure to submit these documents by the deadline established herein will result in the loss of reimbursement for this concept. Under no circumstance shall excess of the invoices filed be paid, nor shall it exceed that provided for within the budget awarded.
2. The documentary evidence of payments made in foreign currency shall be accompanied by a document certifying the euro exchange rate in force at the time of payment. Failure to submit such a document will result in application of the exchange rate in force on the date of processing the payment by the Fundación Seneca.

In the event that the duration of the stay is shorter than expected and funded, and has already been paid, the beneficiary shall refund the proportionate part of the support granted corresponding to the remaining period. The Fundación Séneca will inform the beneficiary of the amount to be repaid.

Under no circumstances shall the stay be less than the minimum established in the Fourth Base. Failure to comply with this condition may lead to the withdrawal of the fellowship and repayment of amounts already received.

The unspent funds must be returned to the Fundación Séneca. The control measures, as well as those resulting from the requirement of reimbursement and the imposition of the corresponding sanctions for



breach of these obligations, as well as other functions involving the exercise of administrative powers shall be exercised by the competent Administration, in accordance with the Sixteenth Additional Provision of Law 38/2003, of November 17, General Subsidies and with article 128.2 of Law 40/2015, on the Legal Regime of the Public Sector.

II) Justification of the scientific activity:

Within **30days** after the termination of the stay, or before September 15, 2018 if the stay ends on June 30, 2018, the following must be filed with the Fundación Séneca:

1. A work report, in Spanish or English, depending on the model provided by the Fundación Séneca.
2. A report by the host group's Principal Investigator on the beneficiary's work activity carried out during the stay, in Spanish or English, depending on the model provided by the Fundación Séneca, stating the start and finish dates.

The last monthly payment and reimbursement of the one way or round trip, if applicable, are subject to receipt of the supporting scientific and economic documentation. Failure to submit these documents within the period prescribed in this section (above) may lead to the loss of the fellowship awarded.

THIRTEENTH. - MONITORING.

The beneficiary shall inform and request permission of the Fundación Séneca regarding any change in the circumstances considered for the award of the fellowship, as well as in the progress of the stay, including its interruption or suspension, which may determine the return of all or part of the amounts received. In the event of unauthorized modifications, the Fundación Séneca may revoke or reduce the fellowship awarded.

The Fundación Séneca shall take the necessary steps to monitor the progress of the funded activity and the use of the fellowship awarded to this end. Grant acceptance implies acceptance of these conditions.

FOURTEENTH. - MENTIONS OF SPONSORSHIP

The successful candidates must acknowledge the funding of the Fundación Séneca on all articles, communications to congresses, publications or other results of the research developed during the stay financed under this call, that they carry out themselves or through the organisations to which they are attached. The following reference should be observed: "This work is a result of the internship (include grant registration number) funded by the Fundación Séneca-Agencia de Ciencia y Tecnología de la Región de Murcia (Fundación Séneca - Agency for Science and Technology in the Region of Murcia) under the "Jiménez de la Espada" Regional Programme for Researcher Mobility, Cooperation and Internationalization".

Also, on all outreach and dissemination materials developed, promoted or coordinated by the funded activity - brochures, books, posters, media advertisements, billboards, advertising signs, exhibitors, banners, Web pages, emails and any other media or material - must also include the logos of the Fundación Séneca and the Autonomous Region of Murcia, which can be downloaded from the following link: <http://fseneca.com/cms/sites/default/files/logos.zip>.

The failure to fulfill the sponsorship regulations that appear in this document might be a reason for total or partial revocation of funding.

Within the framework of activities to promote scientific and technological culture run through its "Scientific and Innovative Culture" Programme, the Foundation may seek the collaboration of the successful candidates for actions aimed at communication and social dissemination of the Results of the activity undertaken.

FIFTEENTH.- FINAL EVALUATION AND RESULTS.

The final report and the results of the work undertaken during the stay will be subject to scientific evaluation. This evaluation may be taken into account in the resolution of future calls by the Fundación Séneca, which reserves the right to publish and disseminate, in any format, the results of the works funded under this call. Pursuant to the current legislation, Fundación Séneca will be joint owner of the results susceptible of



protection, or to industrial and commercial exploitation. Likewise, these results will be incorporated into their databases to facilitate their dissemination and transfer.

SIXTEENTH - DATA PROTECTION

The submission of an application to this Call explicitly authorizes automatic processing thereof, and its incorporation into the corresponding file held at: *La Fundación Séneca, Agencia de Ciencia y Tecnología de la Región de Murcia* and transference of the data to third parties in compliance with the attributed statutory purposes.
